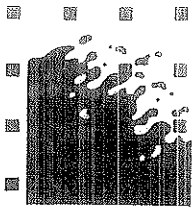



Recently we had to replace a couple of VFDs after hours. The first occurred on a Friday night after a storm. A drive failed on startup and we didn't have a replacement. You were able to come through with a 25 HP the same day along with a technician to help with installation and startup. This was a critical drive on fume hoods that exhaust furnaces and we were able to keep our processes online due to your expedient work.

The next drive we needed was on a Wednesday evening. The unit we had just up and failed, so you promptly got on the horn and had a 50 HP ready to be shipped to us. The following day, we had the drive and a technician on site to perform the installation and startup. This particular drive was for a return fan in a fiber draw area.

Both of these instances, which occurred after working hours, were critical to our research and development efforts and the effort you put into helping us out is greatly appreciated.
